The survey

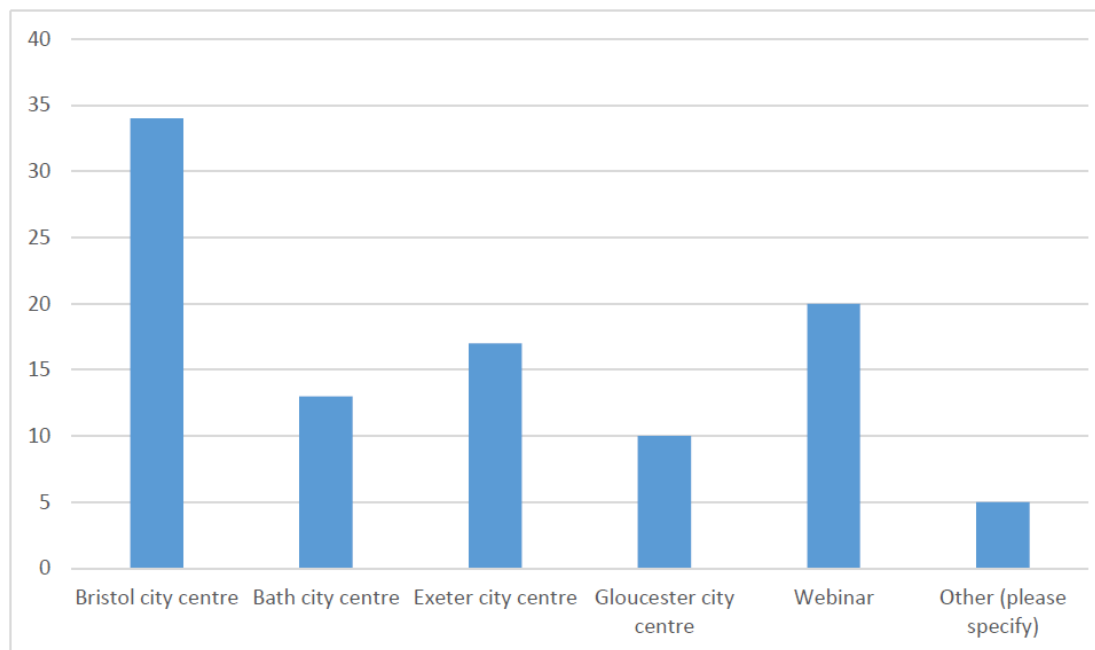
In December 2017 we launched the second annual survey of all members of the ICSA Bristol and District Network. We had 63 people respond to the short survey – an amazing response!

Q1: Where is the most convenient area to attend a CPD meeting? (Please tick all that apply)

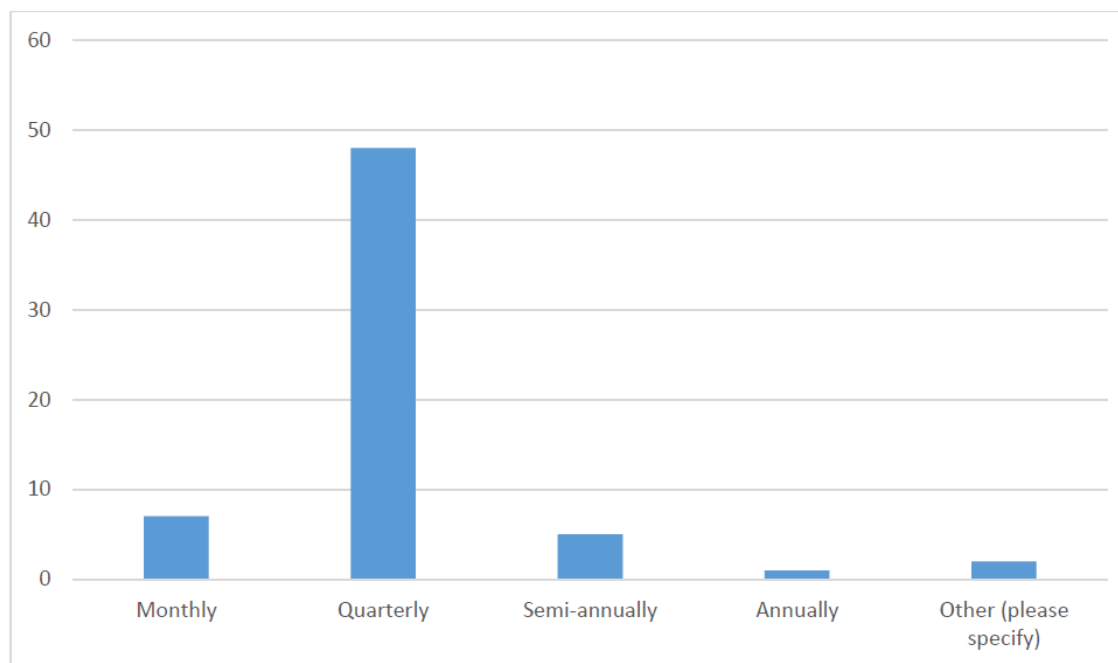


While options for meetings in other locations will continue to be kept under review, **Bristol city centre** remains the most popular location for network meetings.

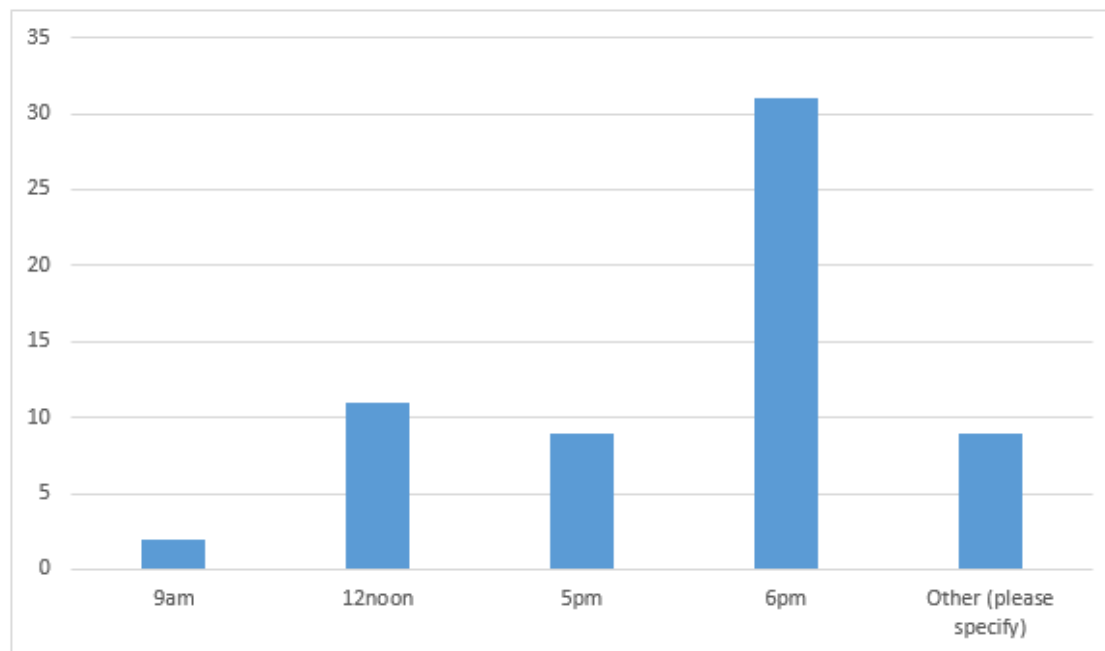
Q2: How frequently would you like CPD meetings to be offered?

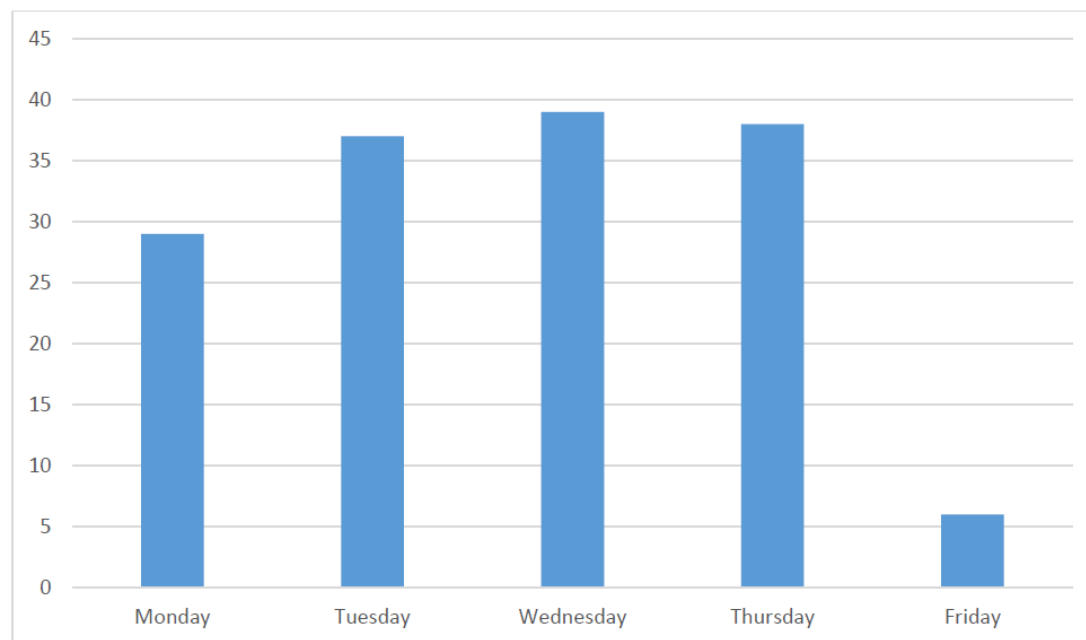
Q3: What time should the ICSA Bristol and District Network meet?

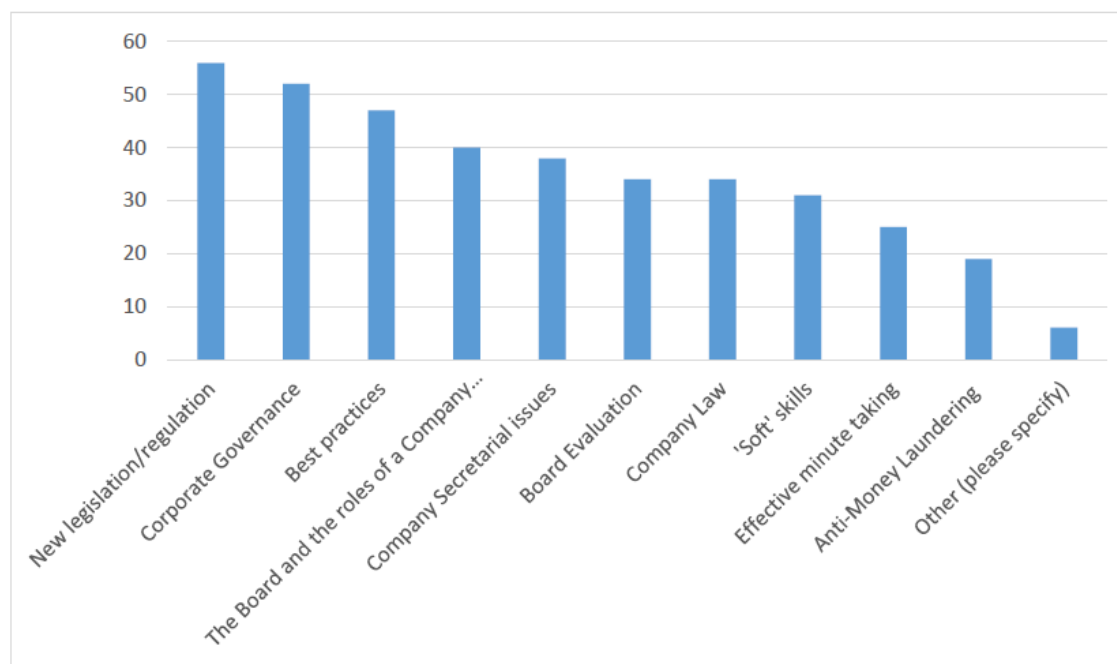
Q4: What day should the ICSA Bristol and District Network meet? (Please tick all that apply)

You said / we did

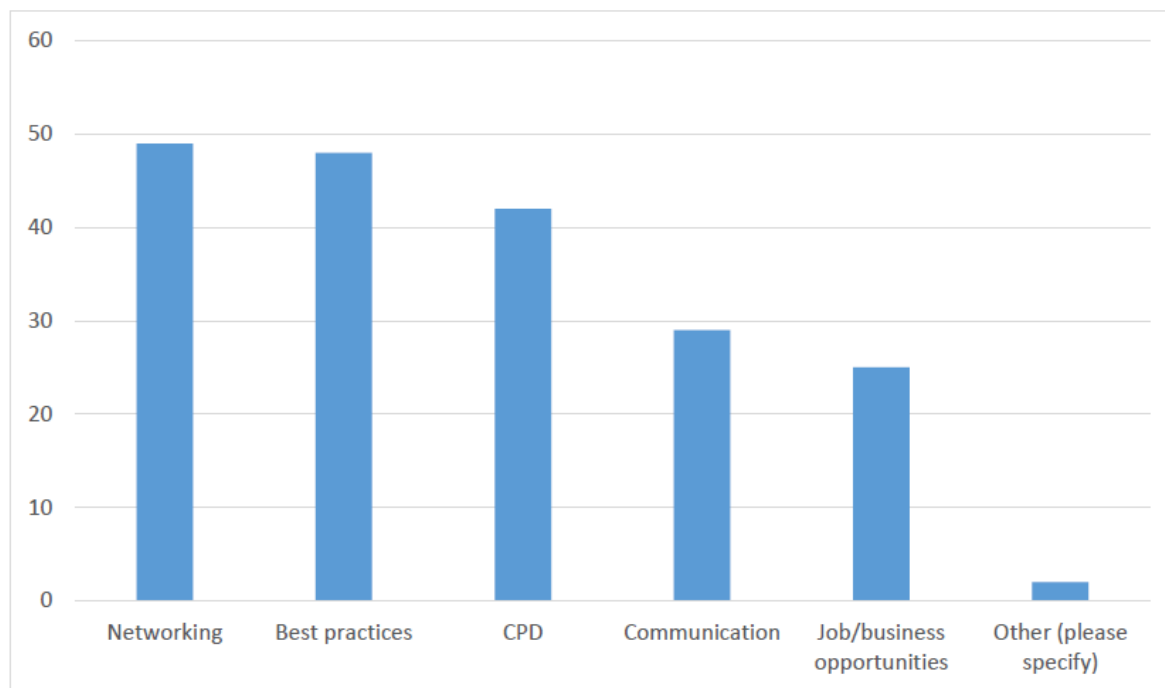
Q5: What topics would you be interested in for future ICOSA Bristol and District Network events?
