2015 Charities Act and fundraising: 1

New terms to be included in written agreements charities have with third parties (professional fundraisers): –

- Voluntary regulation and standards that the commercial organisation has committed to be bound by.
- How the commercial organisation will protect people in vulnerable circumstances and others from unreasonable intrusion into their privacy, unreasonably persistent approaches or undue pressure to donate.
- Arrangements in place that will enable the charity to monitor compliance with the agreement.

2015 Charities Act and fundraising: 2

Charities to include a statement in their annual report, setting out:

- The charity's approach to fundraising.
- Whether a professional fundraiser carried out any fundraising activities.
- Whether the charity or any professional fundraiser is acting on its behalf, is bound by the regulatory system for fundraising.
- Any failure to comply with the regulatory system.
- Whether and how the charity monitored the activity carried out by professional fundraisers.
- The number of complaints that have been received about fundraising activity.
- What the charities have done to protect vulnerable people.

2015 Charities Act and fundraising: 3

Reserve Powers – requirements to:

- Comply with requirements imposed by a regulator.
- To have regard to guidance issued by a regulator.
- To pay fees to a regulator.
- To be regulated with a regulator
